




3-D Pumpkin Directions

Materials: orange construction paper pumpkin templates (10), brown bumpy chenille stem, scissors, glue stick, and glue (Elmer's or tacky)

Directions:


- 1. Start by cutting out your pumpkin shapes.
- 2. Fold each pumpkin shape in half.
- 3. Leaving pumpkin shapes folded, apply stick glue on one outer side. Attach a second folded pumpkin shape on top of the first one, keeping both pumpkin shapes aligned at the edges. Press to glue in place.




5. Move to the stem using the brown bumpy chenille stem. Keep one bumpy part above the pumpkin. You may want to trim some of the interior bumpy fur off of


the bump that will be on the inside of the pumpkin.

(We did not and found we had to hold the pumpkin together longer while drying.)





- 6. Add a line of glue down the center of your pumpkin pile opening. Place the stem into the glue.
- 7. Apply stick glue to one side of the open pumpkin shapes. Bring the two outermost faces together, sandwiching the chenille stem in the middle. Press firmly to glue them in place.



- 8. Let pumpkin dry some before opening up the flaps carefully.
- 9. Shape the stem.
- 10. Decorate your home for the autumn season, Halloween, or Thanksgiving!
