

# Make a Paper Anglerfish

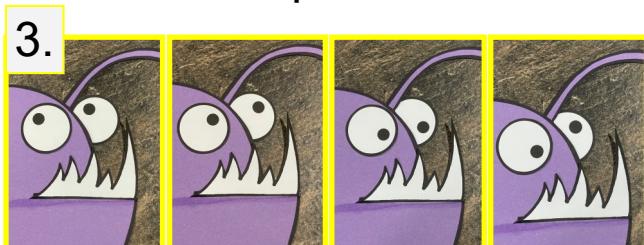
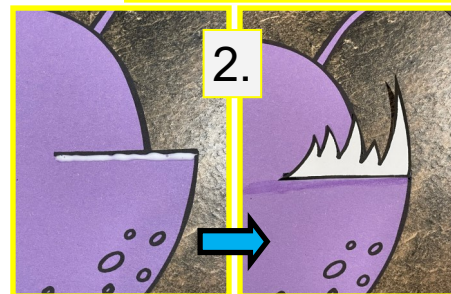


# Paper Anglerfish Directions

**Materials:** Paper templates: body, fins, eyes, teeth; pom pom, pipe cleaner, glue, & scissors

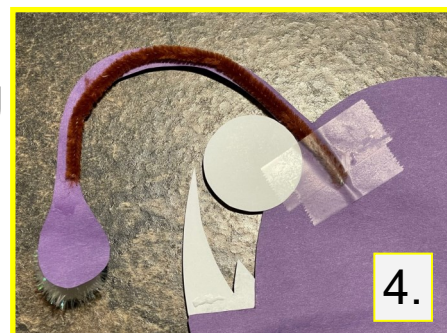
## Directions:

1. Start by cutting out all the paper parts.
2. Glue the teeth onto the mouth area.
3. Glue the eyes above the teeth. One eye will be glued to the backside of the fish and the other on top. Glue however you like.

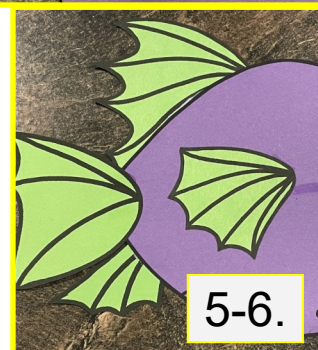


4. Flip fish over. Shape the pipe cleaner to the shape of the "lure" making sure about one inch is on the body and

the rest curves around towards the dangling end. Once shaped, glue the pipe cleaner onto the paper and use some tape on the end over the body to give extra support.



5. Flip the fish back over. Glue the large back fin and the tiny belly fin onto the back end of the fish as shown in the picture.
6. Glue the tail fin onto the back end of the fish. Glue your last fin onto the center of the body.



7. Glue the pom pom onto the end of the "lure" in front of the eyes.
8. All done! Your anglerfish is ready to fish with his bioluminescent lure just like in Finding Nemo!
