

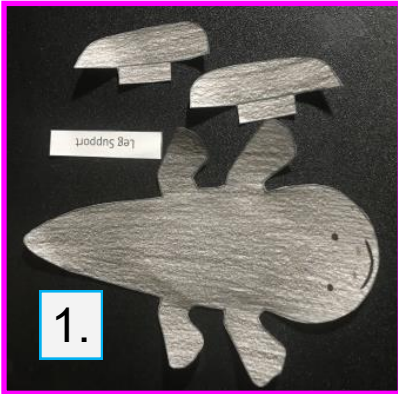
Make A Paper Axolotl



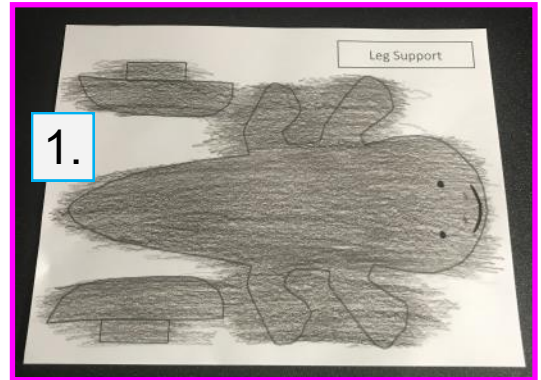
Paper Axolotl Directions

Materials: Paper template, colored pencils, scissors, glue, pink or black pipe cleaner

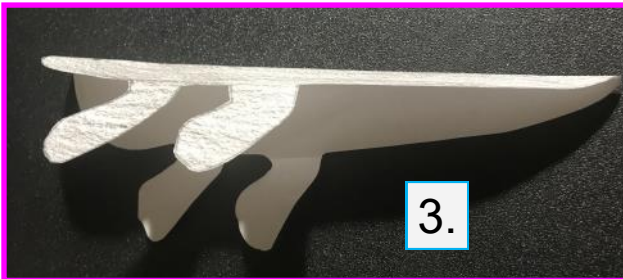
Directions:



1. Color all the pieces of your Axolotl. You can color the rectangle if you want but it will not be seen in the end.

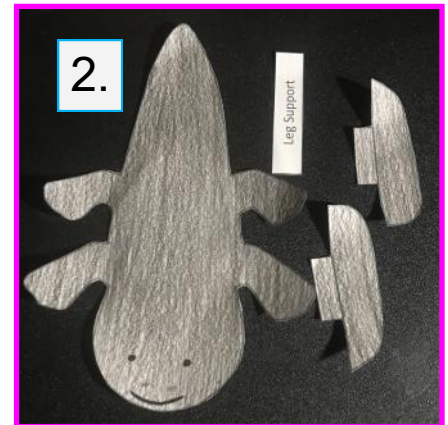


Don't forget to draw on the mouth and eyes.



2. Cut out your pieces.

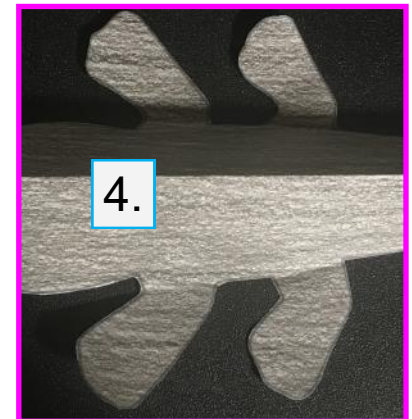
3. Fold the body in half.

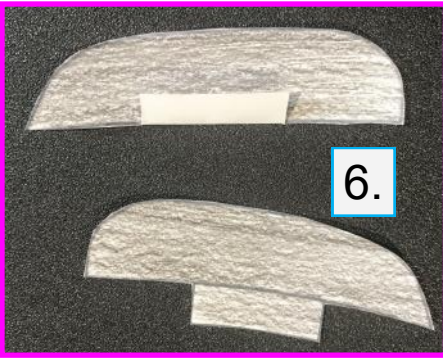


4. Create folds at the legs to help hold up your Axolotl.



5. Flip the body over and glue the leg support to the front legs. This will help your Axolotl keep its shape.

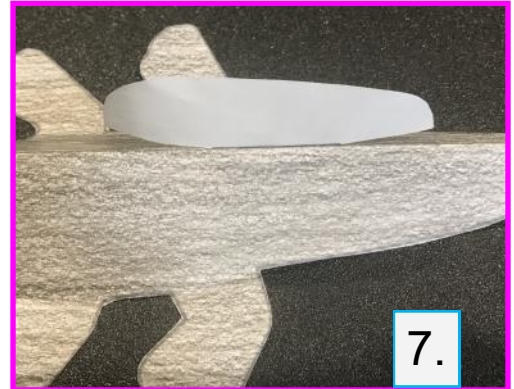




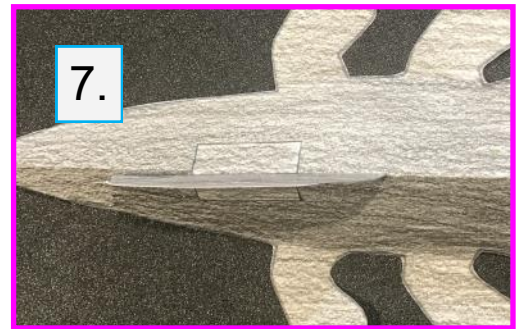
6. Fold the tab on each of the fins.

7. Glue the two fins to the body. You can also glue the tops of the fins together.

8. Cut the pipe cleaner into six equal parts, about 1 inch each.



9. Carefully poke the pipe cleaner pieces through the paper to create gills. Fold the pipe cleaner on the underside to secure.



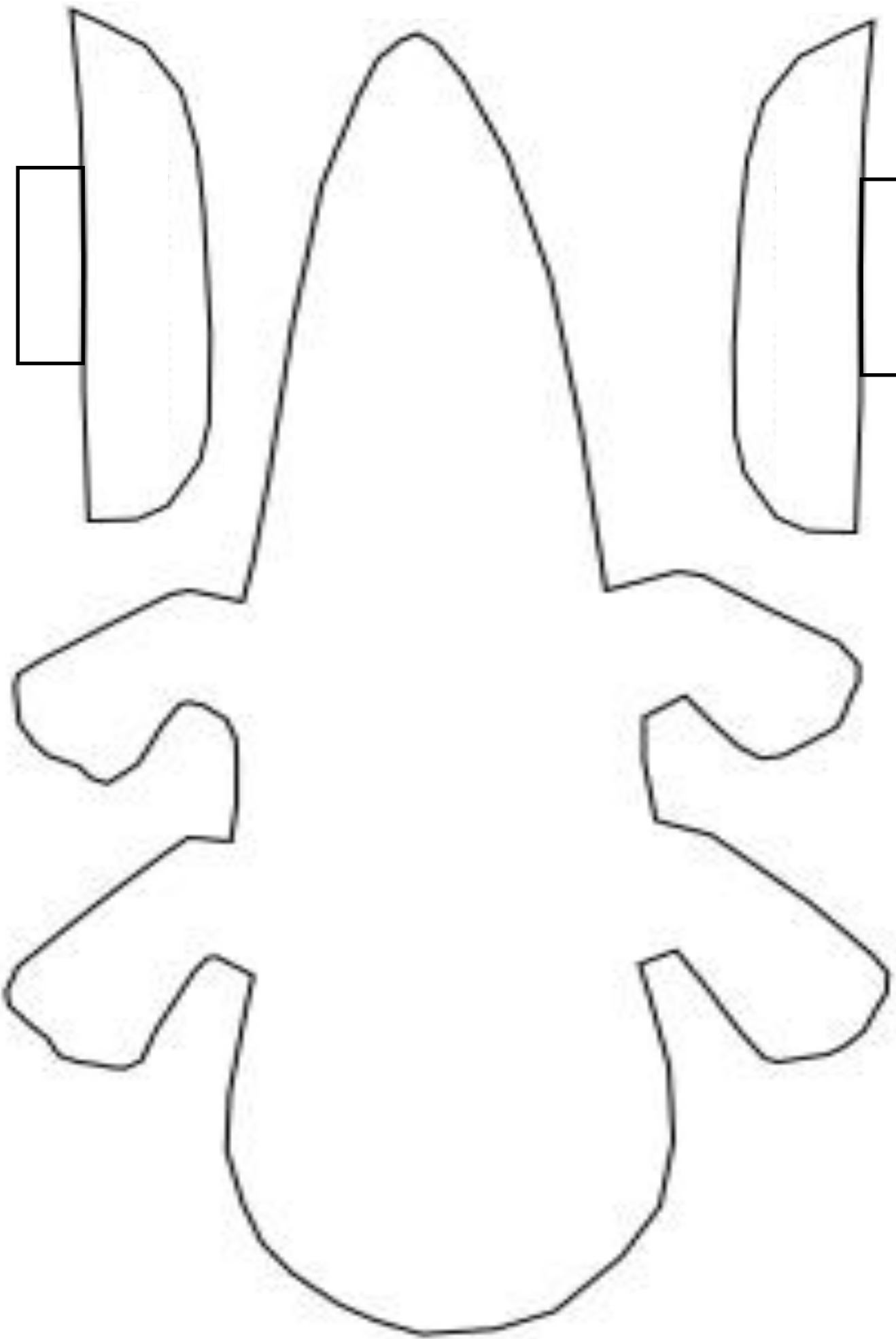
10. Your Axolotl is complete!



Axolotl are a type of salamander. They are normally dark colored for camouflage, but pink ones exist due to a trait that is bred for the pet trade.
