

# Make Clothespin Leaf Turkeys





# Clothespin Leaf Turkey Directions

**Materials:** clothespins, wiggle eyes, fake fall leaves, red paper wattle template, orange paper beak template, scissors, glue, and crayons (black, brown, & green)

## Directions:

**\*\*\*Packets include 2 sets of supplies to make 2 turkeys per person.\*\*\***

1. Start by coloring your clothespins using black or brown crayon. (We lightly colored green on top of the black to give the iridescent color of real turkey feathers.) (You can color one side or both.)
2. Cut out red wattle shapes and orange beak shapes.
3. Glue on your wiggle eyes, beak, and wattle near the top of the open end of clothespin. (Some wiggle eyes have sticker backs. You can try using them, but glue is suggested.)
4. Place a small fake leaf on top of the large fake leaf to make the tail. If you want, you can glue the leaves together.
5. Open the clothespin and clip the leaves between the two sides.
6. Repeat steps 1-5 for second turkey.
7. Your turkeys are complete! Have them 'gobble gobble' on your way home to decorate for the fall and into Thanksgiving!
