

Make A Cotton Ball Stork



Cotton Ball Stork Directions

Materials: Paper template, scissors, colored pencils, glue, cotton balls, pipe cleaner, black construction paper

Directions:

1. Pick your landscape colors and color the background of the stork. Draw a stork's nest, some grass and hills, or both!
2. Cut two, two and a half inch long pieces of pipe cleaner for the stork's feet and glue them onto the stork's body.
3. Cut a one inch piece of pipe cleaner and glue it to the head. This is the stork's beak.
4. Pull apart the cotton balls to make them look more full. Spread glue along the stork's body, neck, and head, and glue the cotton balls to fill the body.
5. Cut out the wing from the black square of paper. Glue this to the body of the stork.
6. Glue the small black circle of paper to the stork's head as an eye.
7. All done! Now you have a cool cotton ball stork!
