

Make Cupcake Liner Hedgehogs

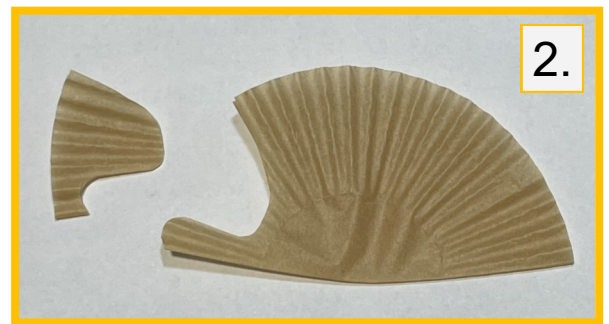
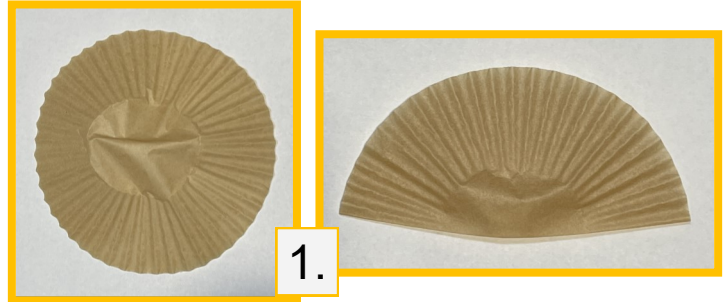


Cupcake Liner Hedgehog Directions

Materials: cupcake liners, construction paper, wiggle eyes, pompoms, glue, markers, & scissors

Directions:

1. Take the cupcake liner and flatten it out. Then fold the liner in half.
2. Use the template to help cut out the shape for a nose and face. Hedgehogs have long noses.
3. To make the spikes or quills, cut both layers of the open side of cupcake liner from the face area all around to the back. Cut down to the smooth center part.
4. To keep the two sides of the folded liner together, open up the liner and place **only a little glue** on the body and nose area of one side and fold back up.



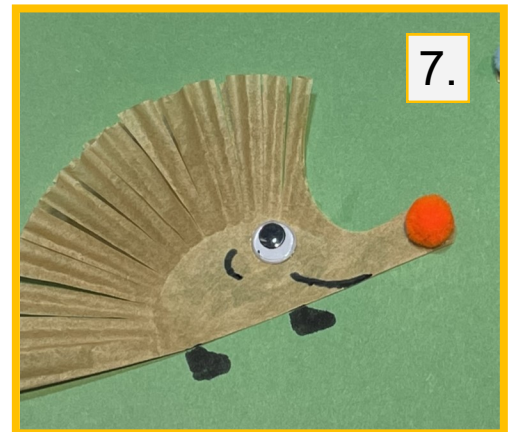
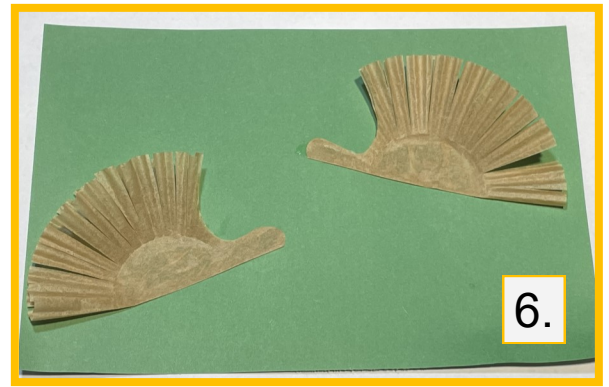
5. Repeat directions 1-4 on other cupcake liner.

6. Glue your two hedgehog bodies to the construction paper.

7. Glue on an eye to each hedgehog. Using a marker, draw the ear and mouth on each. Then glue the pompom nose on each.

8. Decorate the ground around your hedgehogs with the markers.

9. Think of good names for your hedgehogs and you're ready to decorate your home for the fall!



10. Hedgehogs can be found in the wild in Asia, Europe, & Africa and eat insects and worms.
