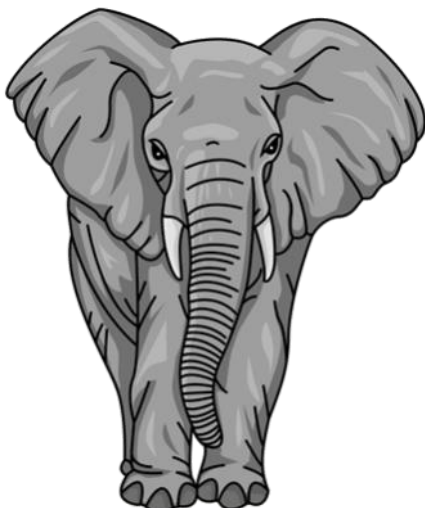
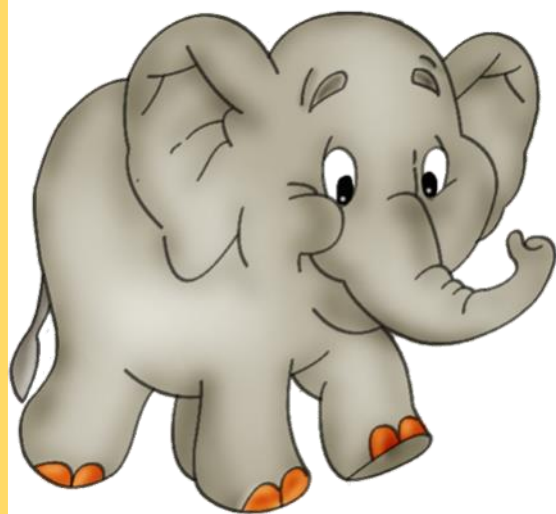


# Make a Elephant Ear Headband & Trunk





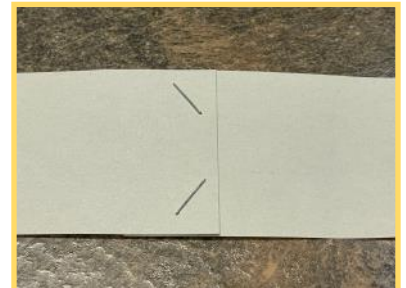
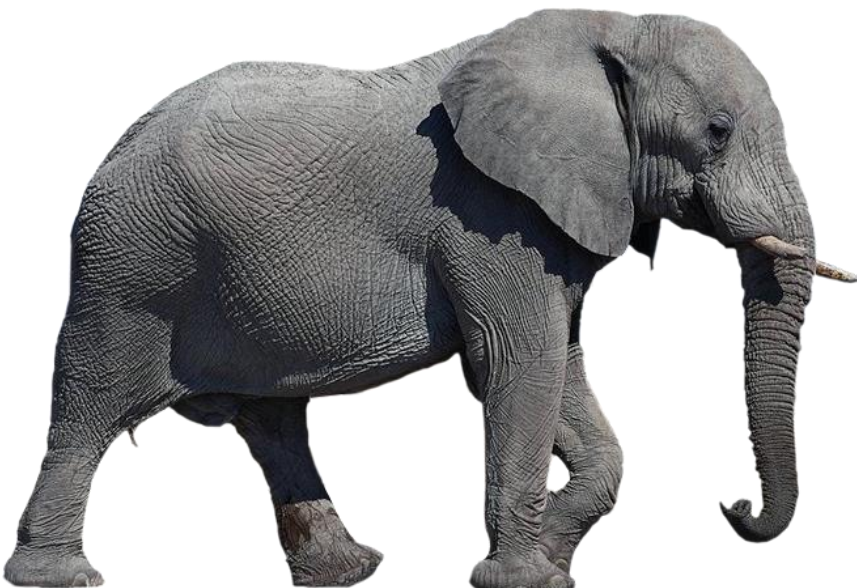
# Elephant Ear Headband Directions

**Materials:** 1 gray construction paper template, yarn, black/gray colored pencil, scissors, hole punch, glue, tape, and stapler

## Directions:

1. Cut out all pieces: ears, nose, and two headband pieces. Make sure to keep the two end strips for the headband.
2. Elephants have wrinkly skin. Add a few wrinkle lines along the trunk using colored pencil. Add some color to the ears as well.
3. Create the headband. Staple the two headband strips together on one end, overlapping slightly. Then staple the other ends together, fitting the headband to the person that is wearing it. This

will make a circle.





4. Flatten the circle to make it easier to attach the ears. (We did this close to the staples.) Start by gluing the ears to the front of the headband as the picture shows. Then flip over and use tape on the backside for extra support.

5. Work on the nose/trunk. Punch two holes on either end of the upper trunk. String the yarn through either side like in the picture.



6. Wear your elephant ear headband and nose around Woodhaven for Halloween!
