



Make a Handprint Paper Piggy




Handprint Paper Piggy Directions


Materials: Pink construction paper, white paper, pencil, markers, glue stick, & scissors

Directions:


1. Using a pencil, trace your hand onto the half sheet of paper. With the excess, draw a tail for your piggy. Do NOT cut yet.



2. At the tips of your fingers draw hooves for your pig. Essentially a triangle with a line above.



3. Its coloring time! Using brown and black markers, add some spots to your piggy and color in the hooves. When done, cut out the pig's body and tail.




4. Cut out the piggy's head. Then, using brown and pink markers, add some spots along with some definition to the pig's ears and face.



Handprint Paper Piggy Directions

5. Cut an oval out of the white square of paper for the piggy's nose. Use a pink marker to color in some nostrils. Glue this onto the pig's face.



6. Using the glue stick, glue the head and tail onto the pig's body (your traced hand). Unlike the picture, you only need a small amount of glue for the piggy's head.



7. You're all done! Now you have a handprint paper piggy!
