

# Make A Lily Pad Frog

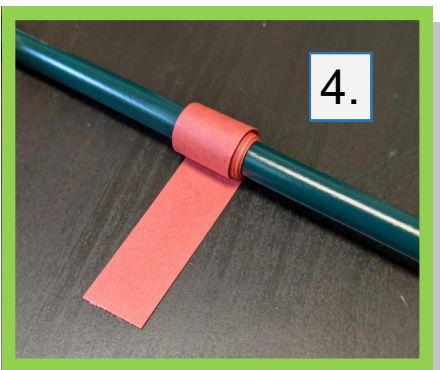
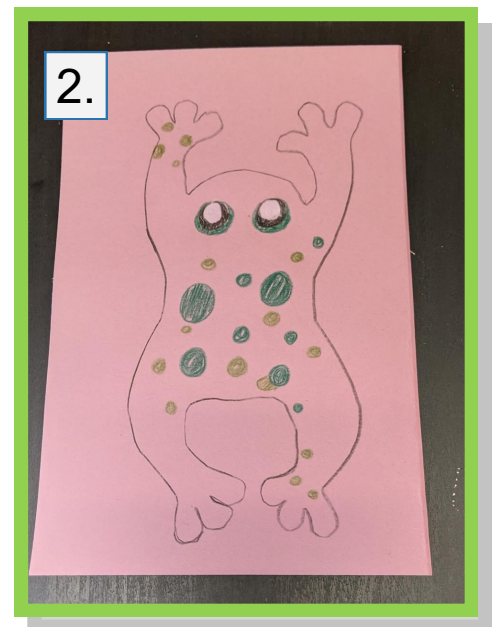


# Lily Pad Frog Directions

**Materials:** Green paper, colored paper, red paper strip, Frog template, scissors, colored pencils, and glue stick

## Directions:

1. Use the template to draw the frog shape onto the colored paper.
2. Give the frog some eyes and spots or other designs.
3. Cut your frog from the paper.
4. Take the red strip and cut it to be the tongue length you want, then roll the paper around a pencil to make it curly.
5. Glue the tongue to the frog, set aside and let dry.

6. Cut two strips off of green paper & set aside.

7. Cut a lily pad shape out of the green paper and draw some leaf veins.

8. To make the spring that the frog sits on, take

your two green strips and glue the ends together at a right angle.

9. Alternate folding the paper strips over each other.

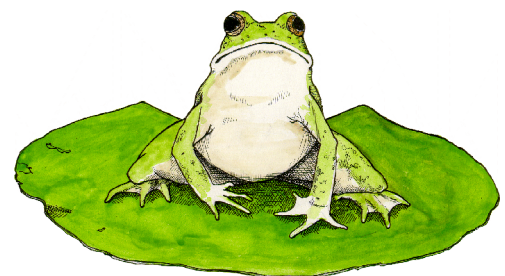
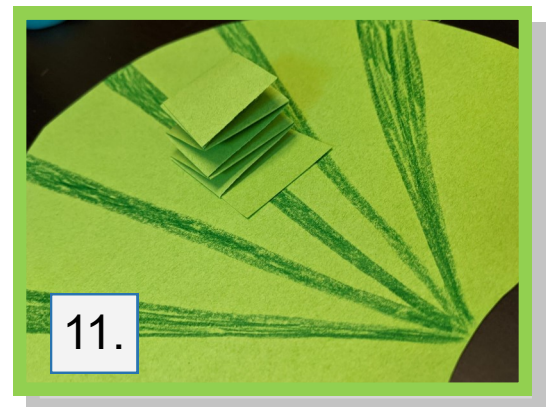
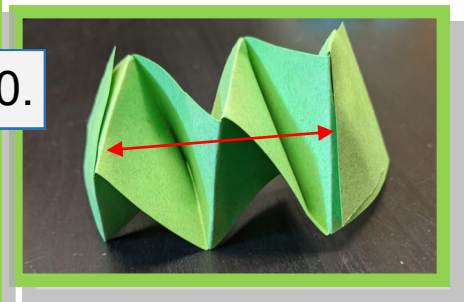
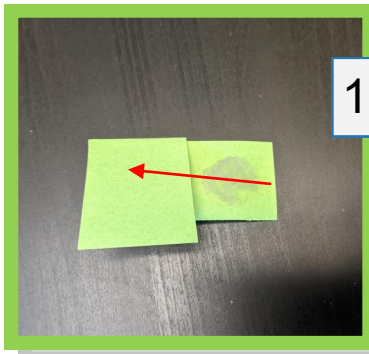
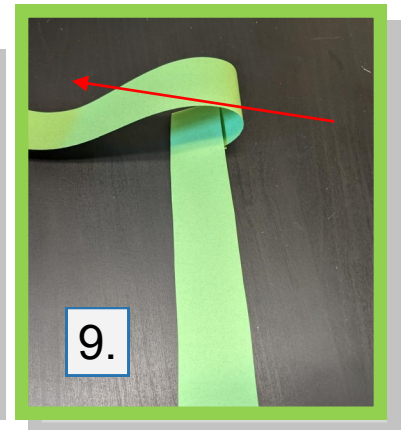
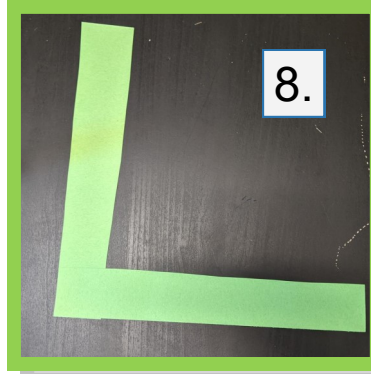
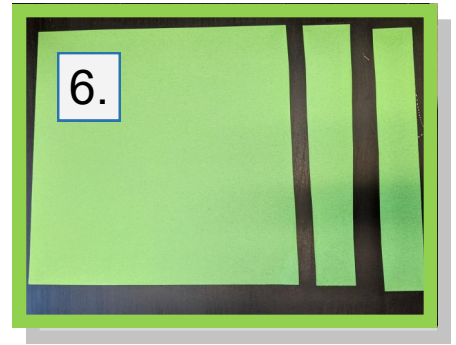
10. When you finish folding, glue the final fold and let dry before stretching your spring out.

11. Glue your spring on the lily pad.

12. Glue the frog to the top of the spring.

13. You're done. Now your froggy can leap up and down on the lily pad!
