


# Make a Paper Armadillo





# Paper Armadillo Directions

**Materials:** brown paper templates, brown pom pom, wiggle eye, brown streamer, scissors, Elmers glue, and brown colored pencil

## Directions:

1. Cut out the rectangle from the template sheet. Fold it accordion style across the long end then set aside.




2. Cut out the rest of the template pieces.

3. Attach the 2 large parts of the armadillo body to the folded paper. Trim the curve and smooth off any rough edges if you'd like.



4. Turn the body over.

5. Carefully cut the streamer into squares and make slices across the bottom of each square, about a third of the way in.



Remember, the streamers are delicate.

6. Add a line of glue across the bottom of the body and place squares of brown tissue paper, leaving the side with cuts to hang over the bottom.




7. Glue the legs to the bottom, on top of the tissue paper. Make sure some of the legs hang below the tissue paper.



8. Add some accordion folds to the tail then glue to the body.



9. Glue the head to the body and glue the ears behind the body. Flip your craft back over so the front is facing you.



10. Use the colored pencil to add details to your armadillo. Glue the eye and nose on too.



11. Your armadillo is complete! Don't forget to give it a fun name.
