



Make a Paper Bag Bat

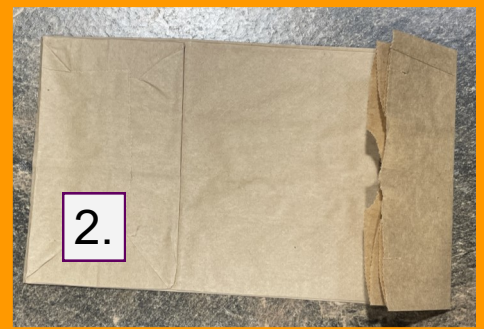
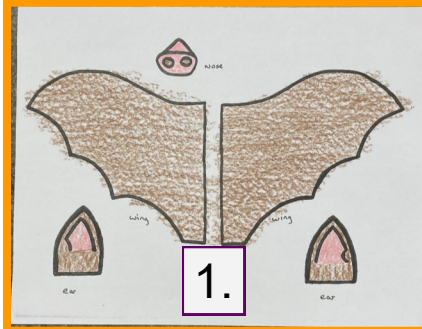


Paper Bag Bat Directions

Materials: 1 lunch-size paper bag, bat parts sheet, sheet of paper, 2 wiggle eyes, glue, scissors, and crayons/marker

Directions:

1. Color and cut out page of bat parts (wings, ears, & nose).

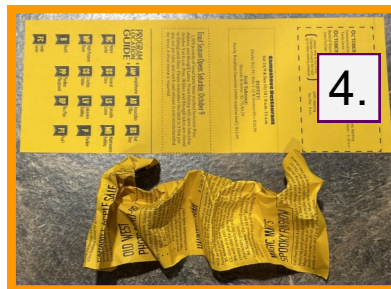


2. Place paper bag, flat with the bottom fold up. Fold the open end of bag 1-2 inches down from top.

3. Turn bag over with "open" folded end at top. This is where you will add a face. Glue eyes and nose near top of bag. Draw a face.



4. Take the two yellow sheets of paper (we used a quarter sheet of an old Leisure Times) and slightly crumple them up. This is used to stuff the bat.



5. Open the bag up and place the two crumpled sheets into the bottom of the bag.



6. Glue top fold of the bag down.

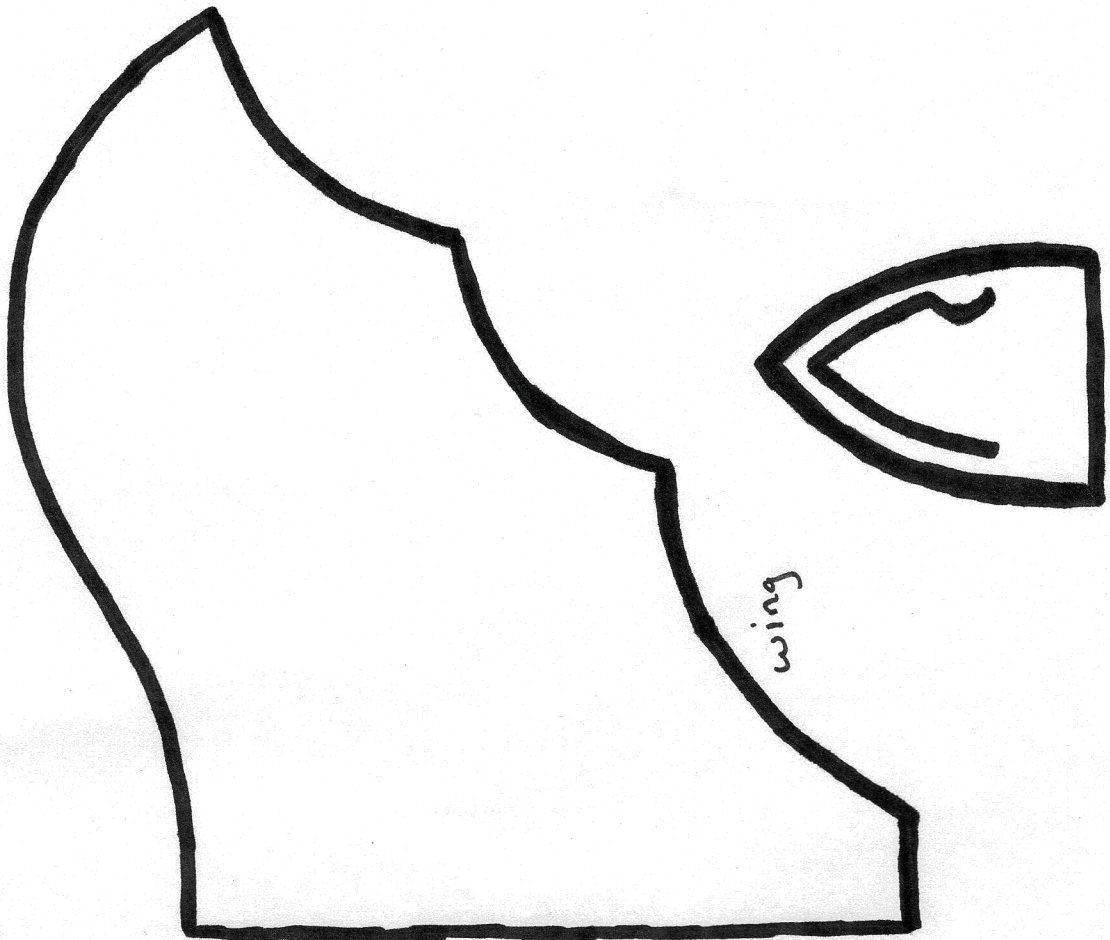


7. Glue ears to top of bag and wings onto each side.



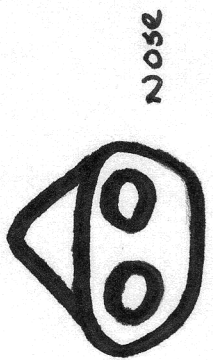
8. Decorate your home for Halloween by setting your bat on a table!



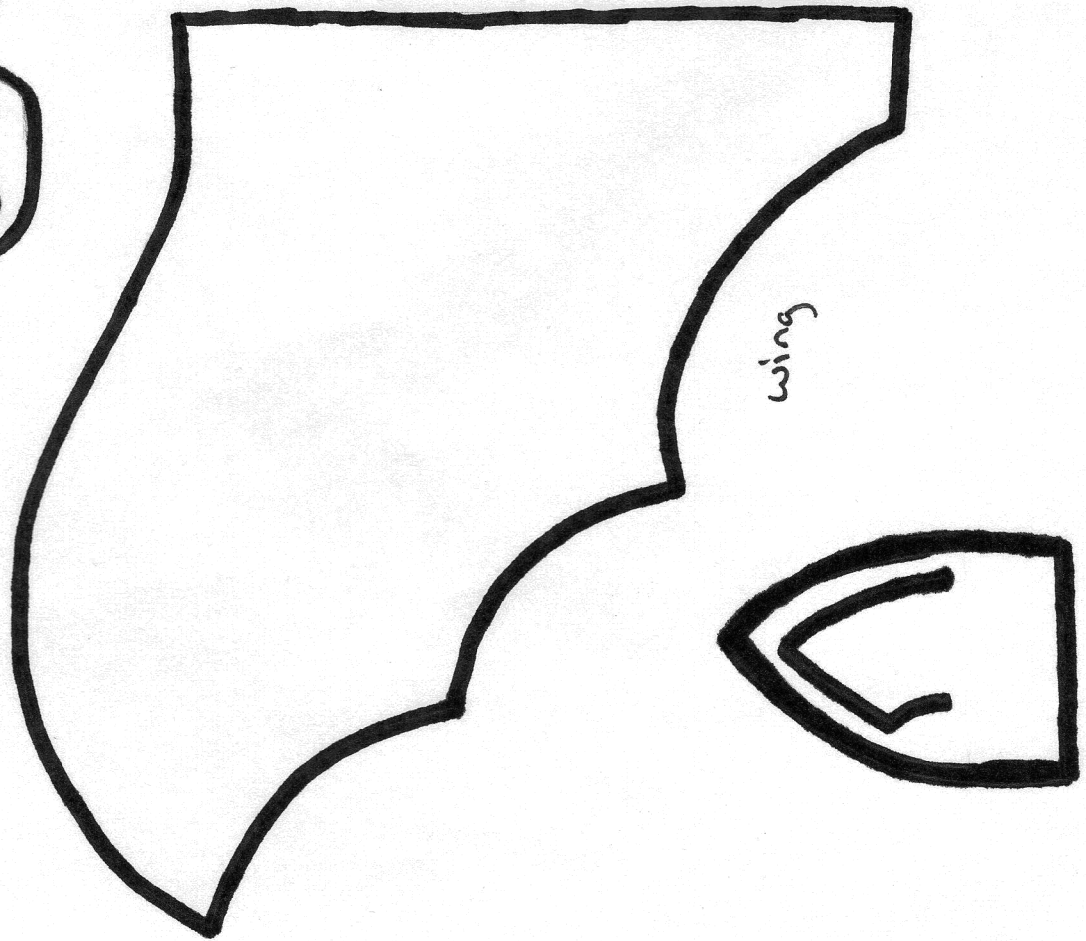


ear
