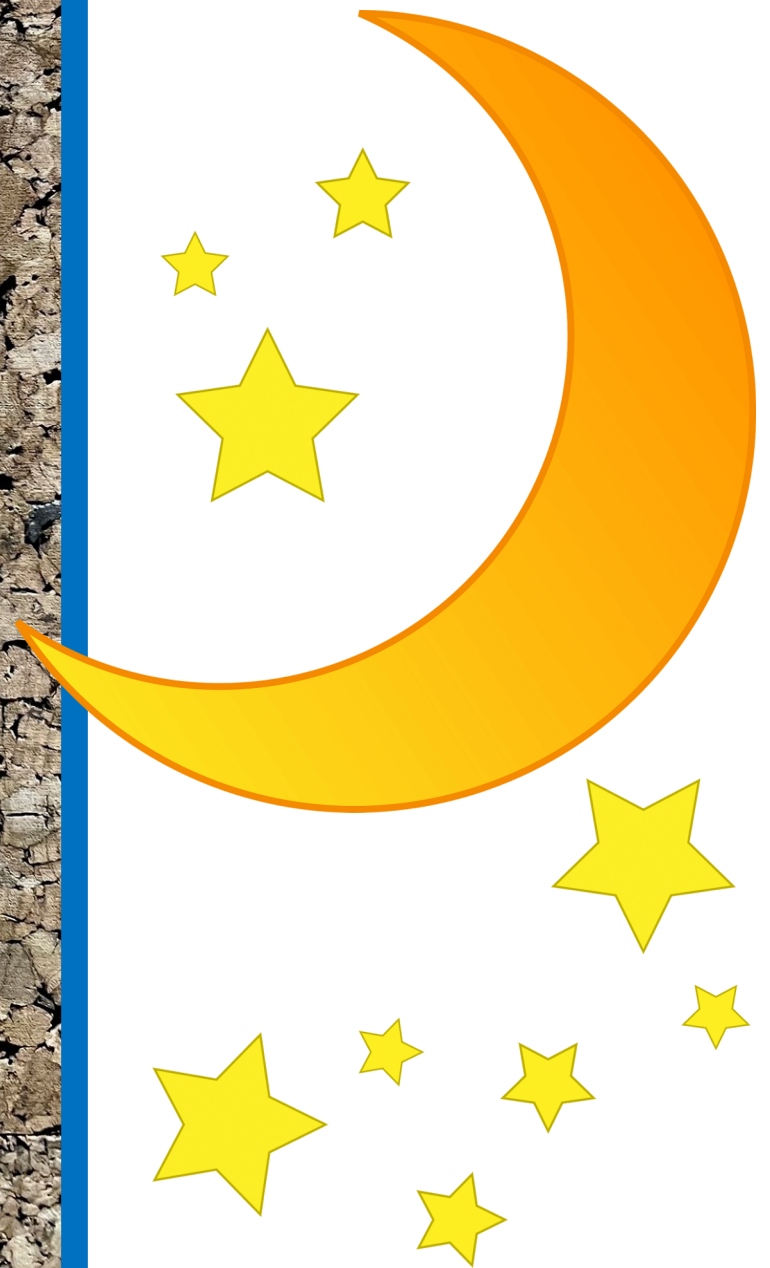


# Make A Crescent

# Moon and Stars

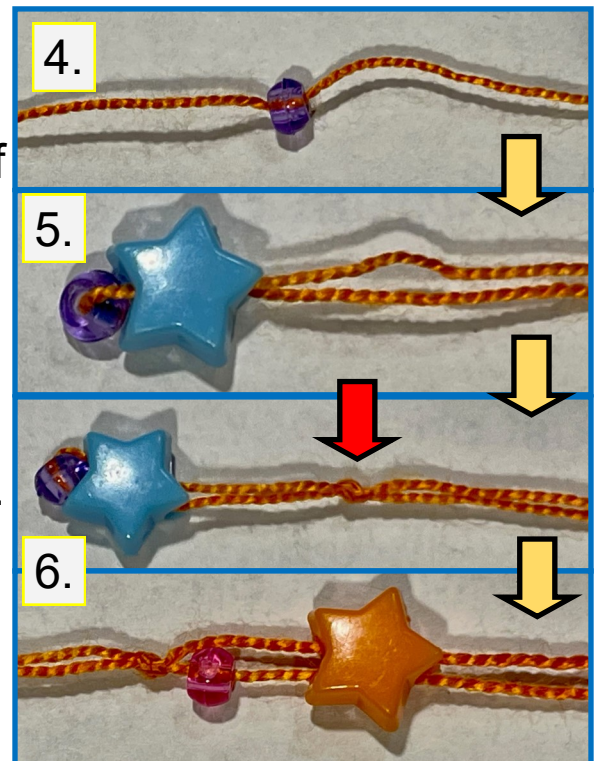
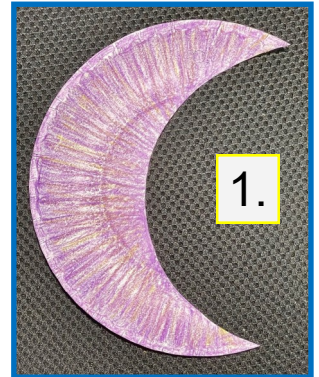


# Crescent Moon and Stars Directions

**Materials:** small paper plate, thread, star beads, smaller beads, crayons, scissors, hole punch

## Directions:

1. Cut out the crescent moon and color.
2. Now work on the hanging star beads. You can mix and match your star beads however you want. We have one hanging from the top of the moon and three groups hanging from the bottom. Follow next step on how to string.
3. Cut thread into 5 pieces of various lengths. One should be put aside for a piece to use as a hanger. Ours are 5, 7, 12, and 14 inches, and hanger. Make sure to have enough to double the length for easy tying.
4. Thread one small bead onto center of a thread. This is a stopper bead to help keep the star bead in place.
5. Thread on a star bead making sure both ends of the thread go through one side of the bead (follow pictures).
6. In the spot where you want the next bead you'll need to place a small knot. Then thread on a small bead on one string followed by the star bead with both ends through one side of the star bead.

7. Repeat steps 4 through 6 for each string of beads that you're hanging.

8. Now punch holes into the moon in the locations you want to hang your stars. Tie the strings through the holes.

9. Make a hole near the top of the moon to tie the final string as a hanger.

10. Hang your moon and stars up to celebrate the beginning of fall this weekend!
