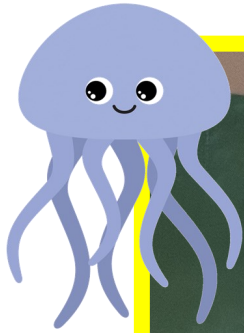


Make a Paper Plate Jellyfish

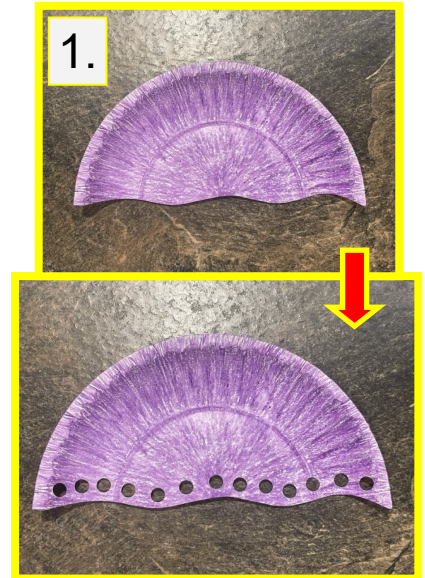


Paper Plate Jellyfish Directions

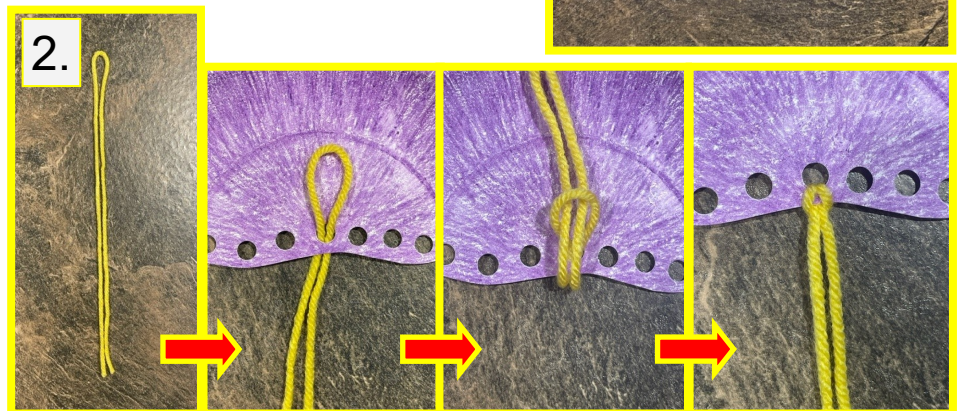
Materials: Paper plate, yarn, hole punch, black colored pencil, crayons & glue

Directions:

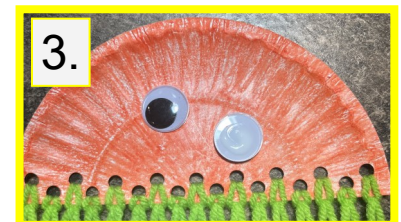
1. Start by coloring the paper plate half. If you would like, you can cut a wave pattern at the bottom of the plate. Or, you can leave it straight. After the plate is colored and cut to your liking, use the hole puncher to cut 13 holes along the bottom. *if more holes are punched you will need to cut pieces of yarn in half to fill them in half to fill them



2. To make the tentacles, fold a piece of yarn in half and feed the loop about an inch through the

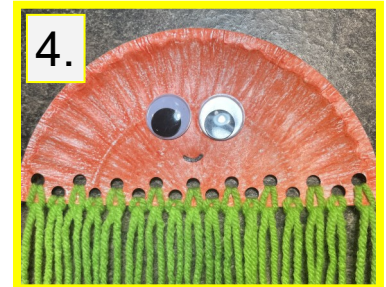


punched hole. Now feed the yarn through the loop and pull to tighten. Don't pull too hard though, you don't want to tear your plate!



3. Once all the yarn is attached, glue the wiggle eyes to the plate.

4. Use the black colored pencil to add an expression to your jellyfish.



5. All done!
