



Make a Paper Pumpkin Jack-o-Lantern

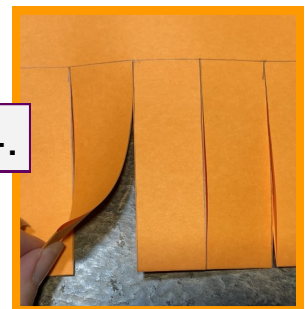
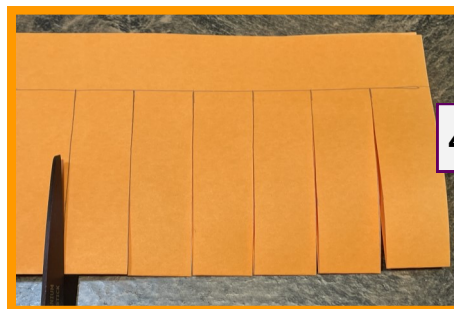
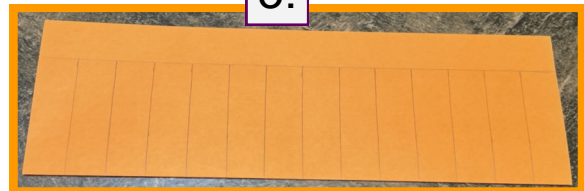
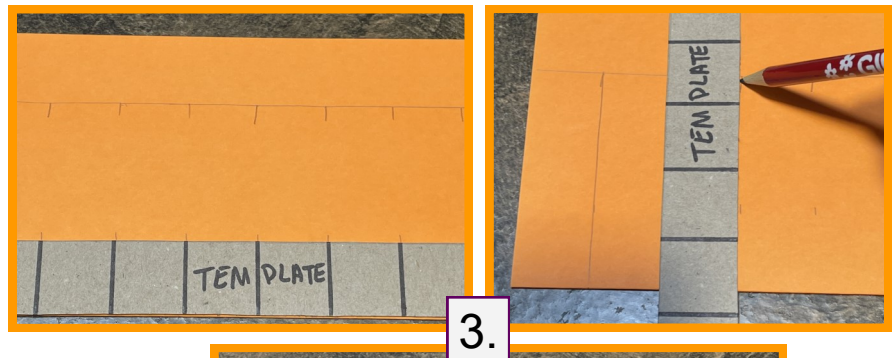


Paper Pumpkin Jack-o-Lantern Directions

Materials: 1 piece orange paper, black construction paper, 1 green pipe cleaner, tape, glue, scissors, and pencil

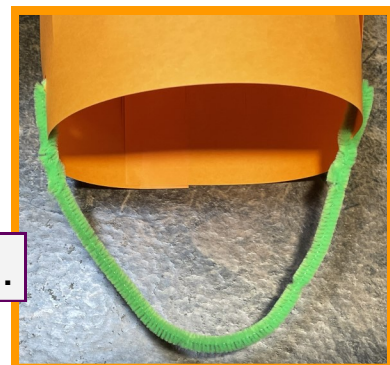
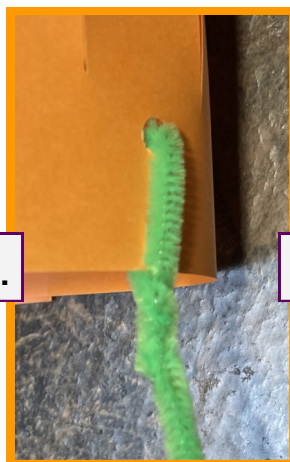
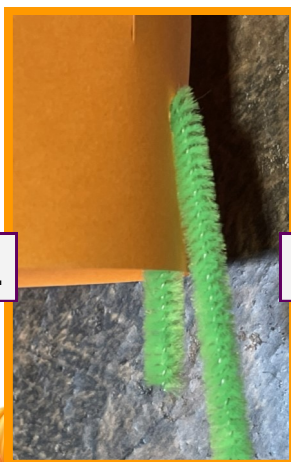
1. Fold orange paper in half, lengthwise.
2. Use template (or ruler) to measure 1" from the open side of the folded paper and draw a line. (This makes the uncut edges of the lantern.)
3. Use the template to mark the cutting lines on the folded edge of the paper, each line is 1" apart.
4. Cut along the 1" apart lines; only cut up to the original first line and no further.
5. Unfold the paper. Take one end and wrap into a tube. Tape each end of the lantern where the two ends meet.



6. Cut out some shapes for your jack-o-lantern face. These can be any shapes out of black paper.

7. Glue shapes to the lantern as shown in the picture. Laying the lantern on its side will help with this part.

8. Using hole punch, punch a hole on either side of the lantern top. Bend your pipe cleaner in half to make it easier to use. Thread one end into the hole and twist the end around to tie off. Do the same with the other side hole.



9. Decorate your home for Halloween by hanging your lantern up!
