

Make a Patriotic Windcatcher



Patriotic Windcatcher Directions

Materials: Blue plastic cup, star stickers, red yarn, white yard, black twine, hole punch, ruler, scissors, pencil

Directions:



1. Begin by cutting both the red and white yarn into 6 equal pieces.



2. Punch holes in the rim of your cup. Start with punching



2 holes across from each other.

3. Turn your cup and punch 2 more holes across from each other.



4. Fill in the gaps to have a total of 12 holes.

5. Take one piece of yarn and fold it in half.



6. Take the loop and feed it through one of the holes in the cup. Feed the yarn from the inside of the cup so the loop comes out on the outside.



7. Feed the tails of your yarn through the loop and pull tight.

8. Repeat steps 5-7 for the rest of your yarn. Alternate using red and white yarn.



9. **Optional:** Trim the yarn to your desired lengths. At home, you can add a drop of glue to each knot to hold tighter.



10. Place your star stickers around the outer sides of the cup.

11. Feed both ends of the twine through the hole in the bottom of your cup.



12. Carefully pull the ends through. You may want to slide a pencil through the loop of twine so it stays tight.



13. Your Patriotic Windcatcher is complete! Hang this craft outside this weekend to celebrate the Fourth of July.
