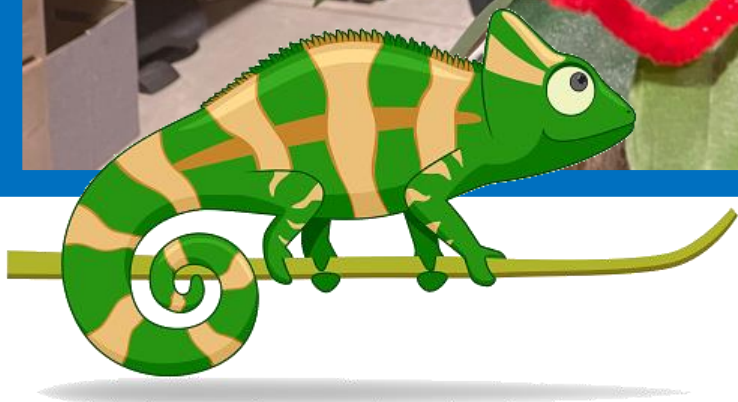


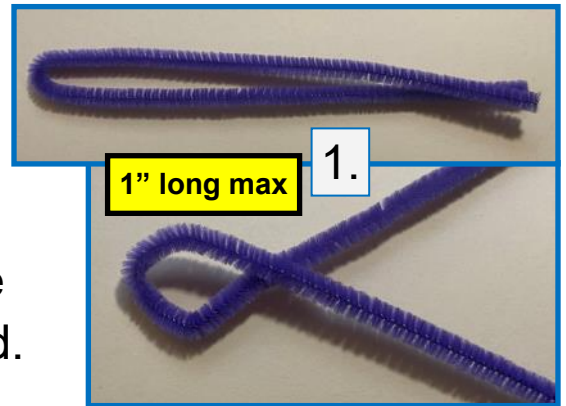


Make a Pipe Cleaner Chameleon



Pipe Cleaner Chameleon Directions

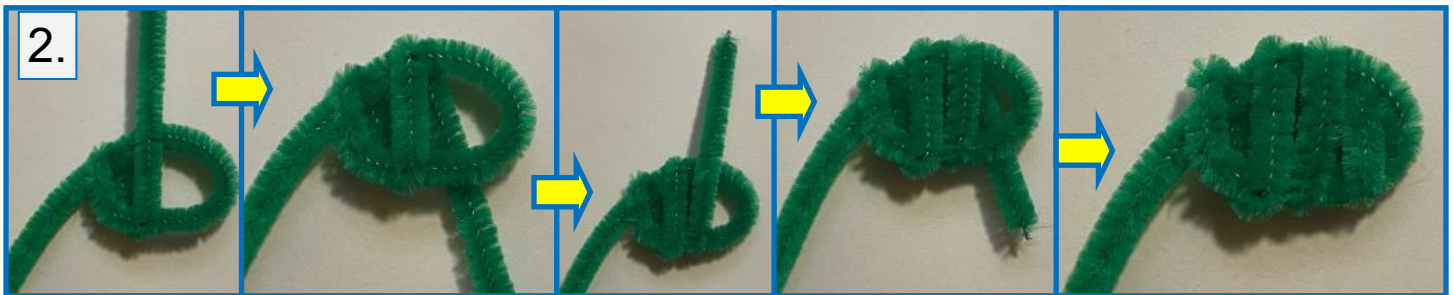
Materials: pipe cleaners, wiggle eyes, paper, tacky glue, and scissors



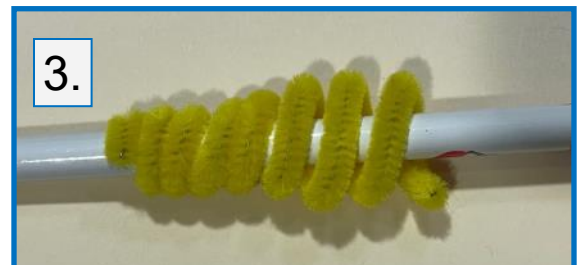
Directions:

1. Loop one long pipe cleaner in half. The circle part will be the chameleon's head. (This should be 1 inch around max!)

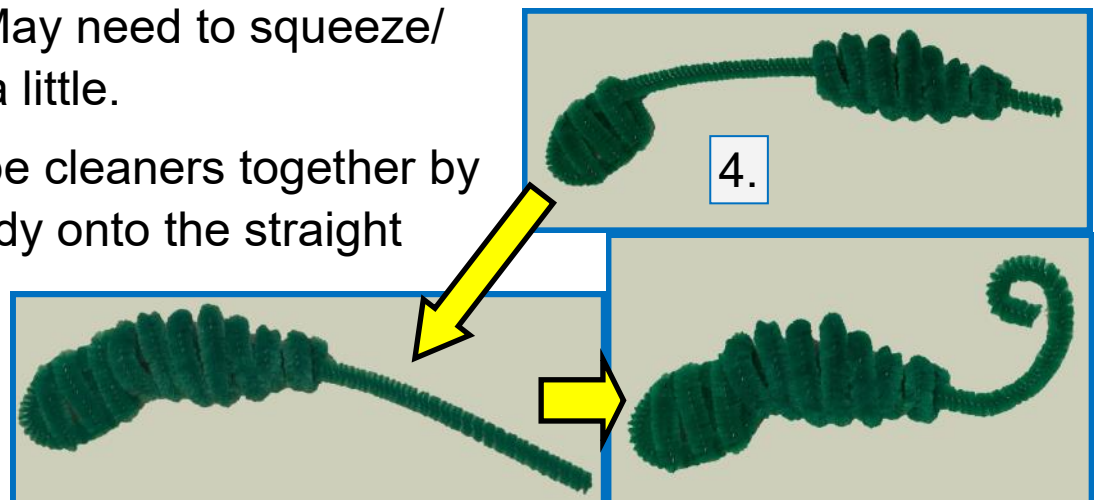
2. Wrap/loop one of the halves of the pipe cleaner around the 'head' until it is covered.



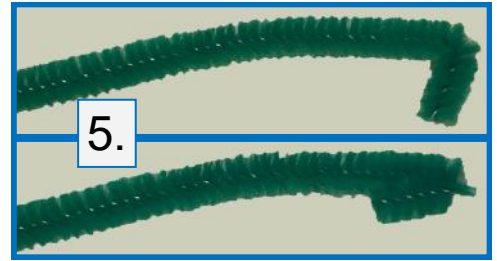
3. Coil a second long pipe cleaner around a pencil, coiling tight at one end and more loosely toward the other end, if possible. This makes the body more full. Remove from pencil. May need to squeeze/flatten down a little.



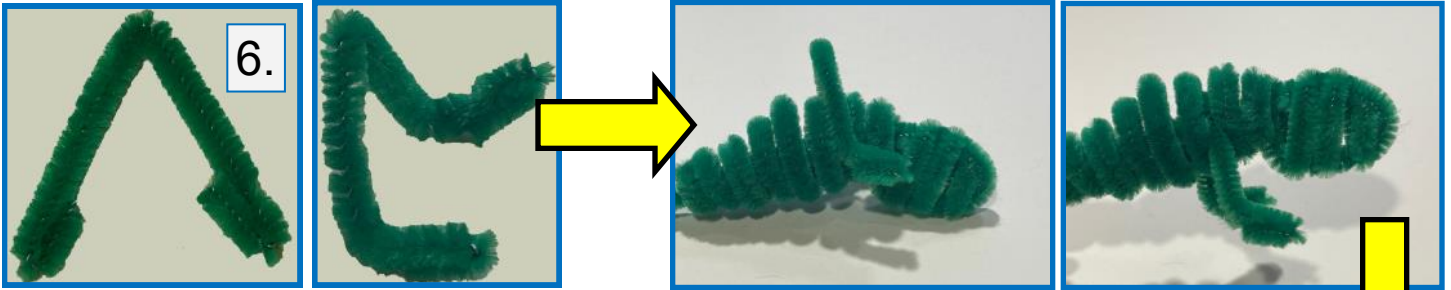
4. Attach the pipe cleaners together by sliding the body onto the straight piece from the head. Curl the tail.



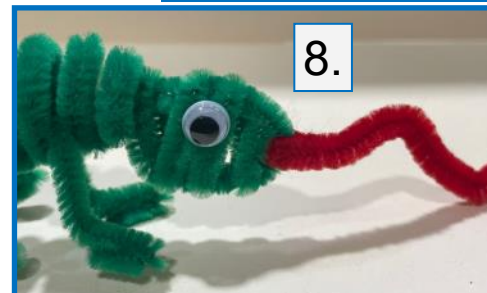
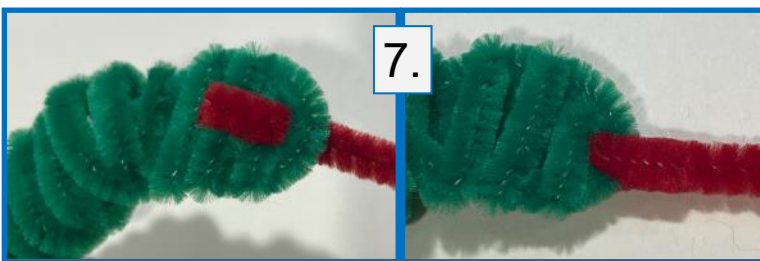
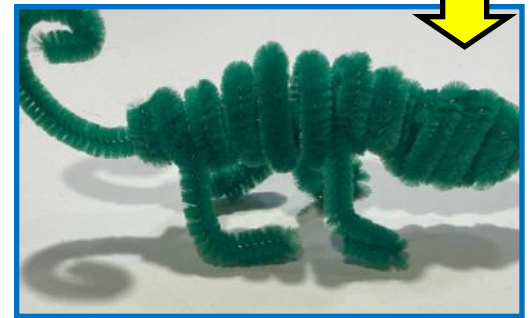
5. Make the legs. Take a short pipe cleaner and bend both ends over about 1/4 inch to make feet.



6. Attach the legs. Start by folding the pipe cleaner in half and then fold the feet up a little. Then slide the front legs on between the first couple 'ribs' of the body. Slide the back legs on between the last couple 'ribs' of the body.



7. Attach the red pipe cleaner 'tongue' to the chameleons mouth/head. Just slip through front and fold over. Fold tongue to a fun shape. Chameleons have very long tongues to catch their food!



8. Glue on wiggly eyes.

9. Cut out a leaf shape from the construction paper. You can set/ glue your chameleon to the leaf if you want.

10. Hide your chameleon around the house or take pictures of your chameleon in fun places! Real chameleons can change colors to hide in their environments!
