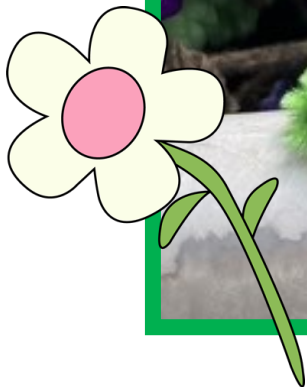
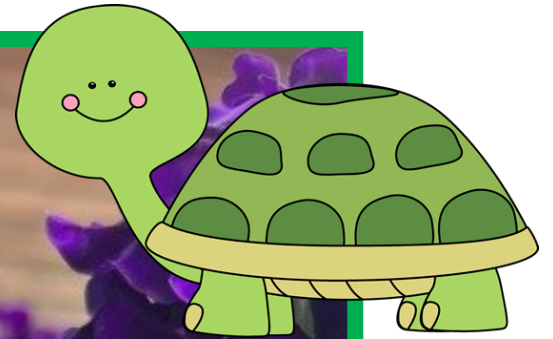


Make a Pipe Cleaner Turtle

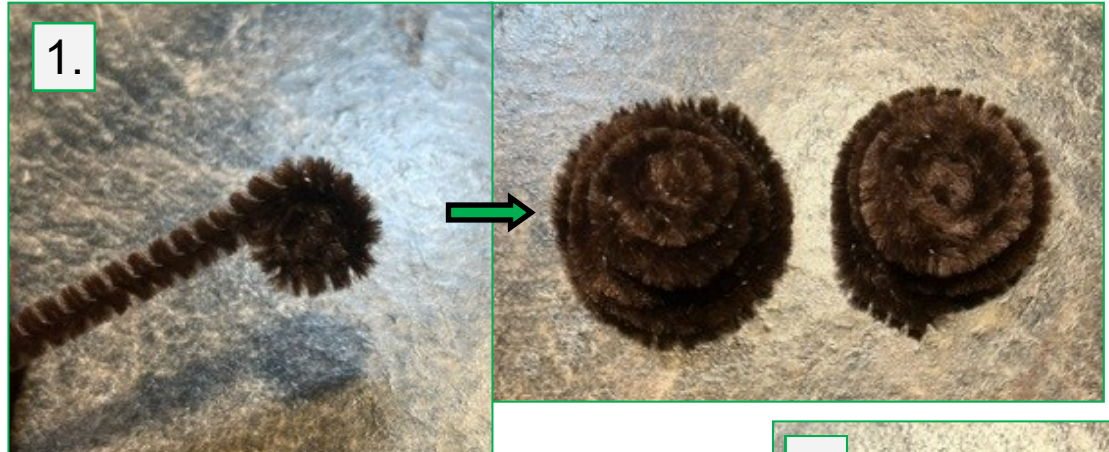


Pipe Cleaner Turtle Directions

Materials: 2 brown pipe cleaners, 2 green pipe cleaners, 2 wiggle eyes, tacky glue, scissors

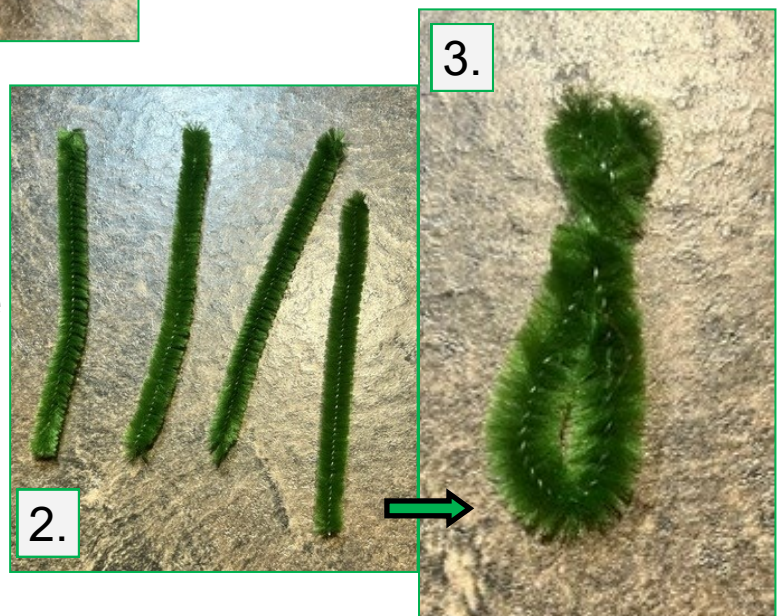
Directions:

1. Begin by tightly rolling the brown pipe cleaners.



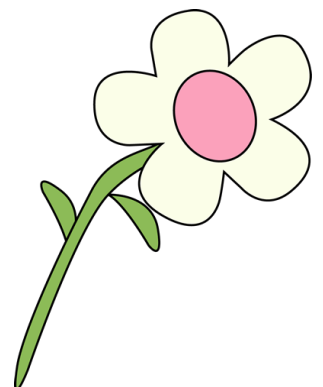
2. Cut one green pipe cleaner into fourths.

3. Fold and fourth in half and twist the end. Repeat this for each fourth piece. These are the legs.

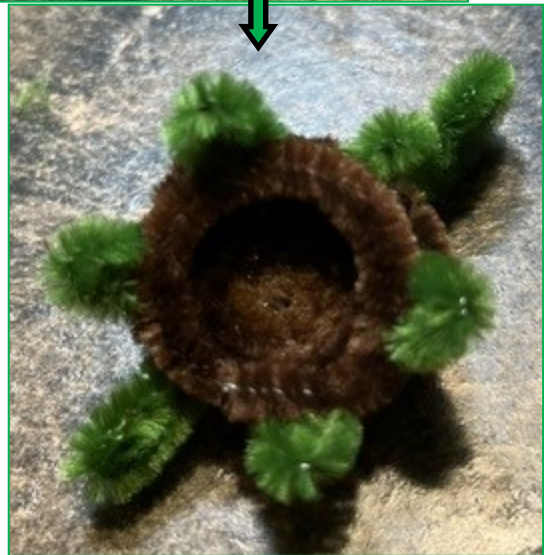


4. Cut the other green pipe cleaner in half. Start rolling one half. Make the roll however big you want the turtles head. Leave about one inch and cut off the excess.

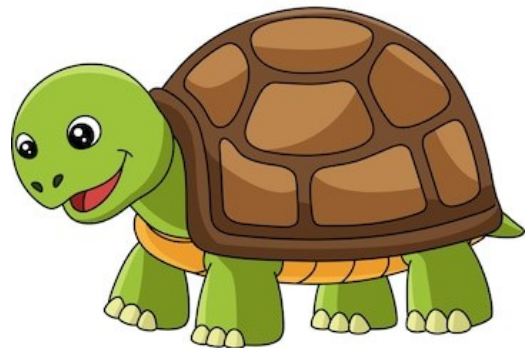
5. Use the other half of the green pipe cleaner to make the tail. Fold and twist just like the legs (step 3).

6. Glue the head, legs, and tail to the underneath of a brown pipe cleaner circle.
7. Glue the second circle over top the legs. Make sure the curve of the circle is matching the top shell of the turtle.
8. Glue a wiggle eye on each side of the turtle's head.
9. You're done!
