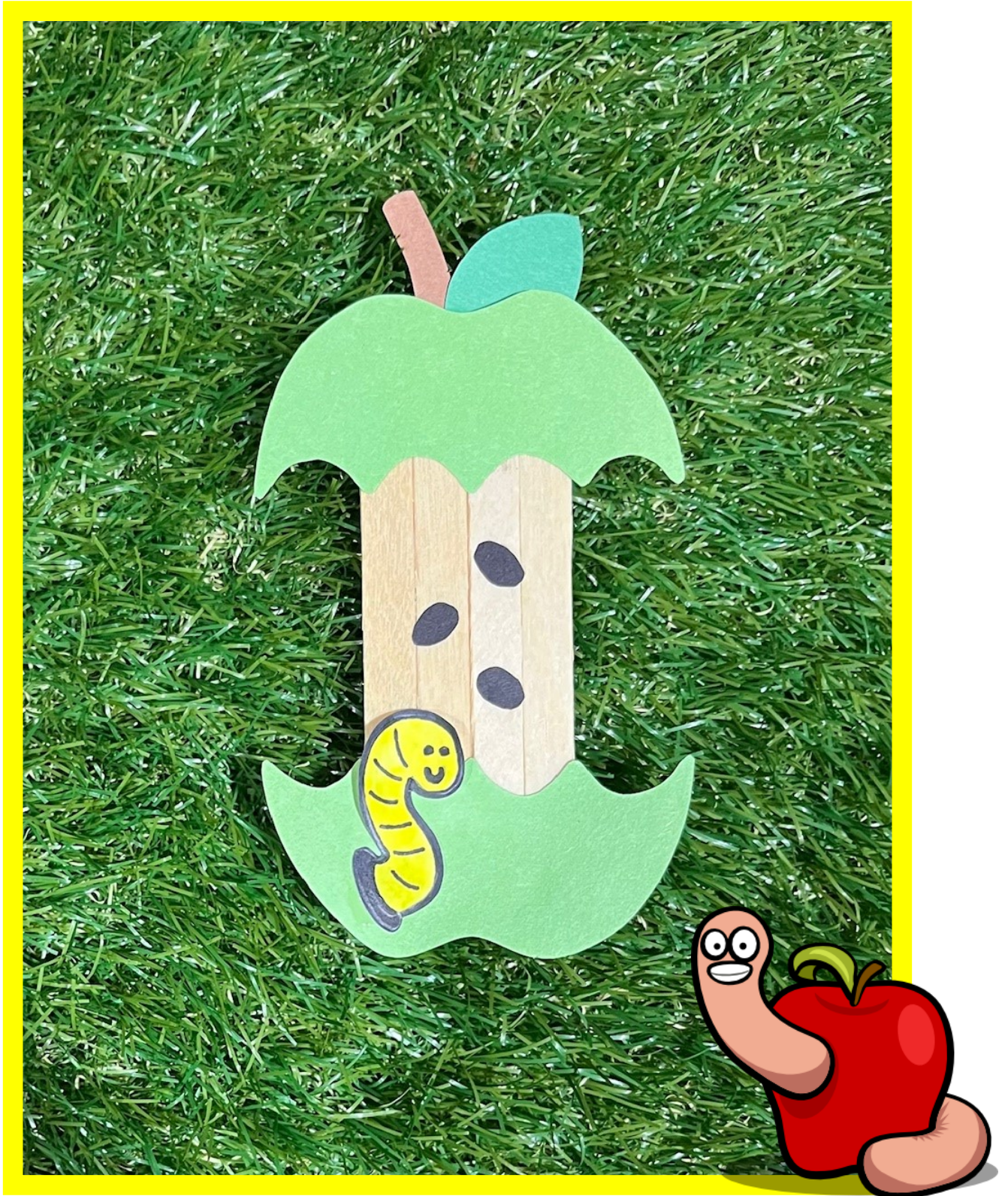


Make a Popsicle Stick Apple Core

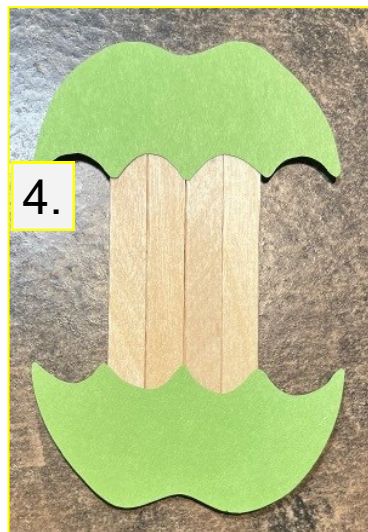
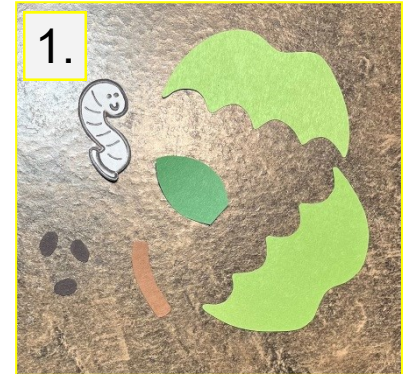


Popsicle Stick Apple Core Directions

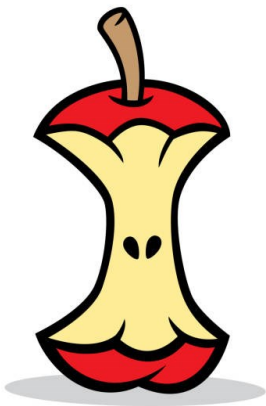
Materials: 4 popsicle sticks, stem, leaf, apple, & worm construction paper templates, black construction paper, white paper, markers, scissors, Elmers glue

Directions:

1. Begin by cutting out all templates (apple halves, leaf, stem, and worm). Then using the black paper, cut out some ovals for seeds.
2. Color the worm however you'd like.
3. Glue the white construction paper rectangle to the back of the four popsicle sticks to keep them together.



4. Glue the apple halves to either side of the popsicle sticks.



5. Finally, glue the leaf, stem, seeds, and worm onto the apple.



6. You're all done!
Don't try eating this apple, it won't taste very good...
