

Make A Popsicle Stick Scarecrow



Popsicle Stick Scarecrow Directions


Materials: popsicle sticks, match sticks, yellow construction paper, heavy paper piece, yarn, wiggle eyes, colored pencils, glue, scissors

Directions:

1. Glue the four popsicle sticks in a row on the rectangle heavy paper piece.




2. Color your scarecrow. The bottom half of the scarecrow is the body. To figure out how much of the top to color for a hat, layout the match sticks and color the area above




hat, layout the match sticks and color the area above

3. Color the match sticks to match the hat.




4. Cut the yellow paper into strips (thick or thin) for the hair. Glue the hair along the hat-colored area.



5. Glue the match sticks on over the hair to make the hat brim.


6. Make a bow out of the piece of yarn. Glue bow under chin. You may need to cut some of the extra yarn off.

7. Work on the scarecrows face. Draw a mouth and nose. Glue on the wiggle eyes.

8. Once dry, take your finished craft out to the matching life-sized scarecrow in the front yard and take a picture together with your scarecrow!
