

Make a Popsicle Stick Snowman

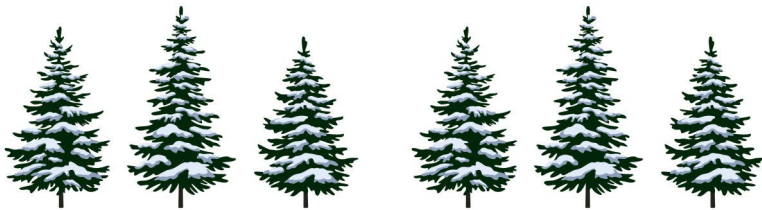
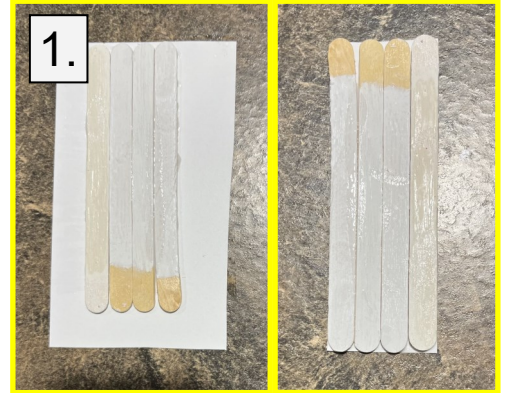


Popsicle Stick Snowman Directions

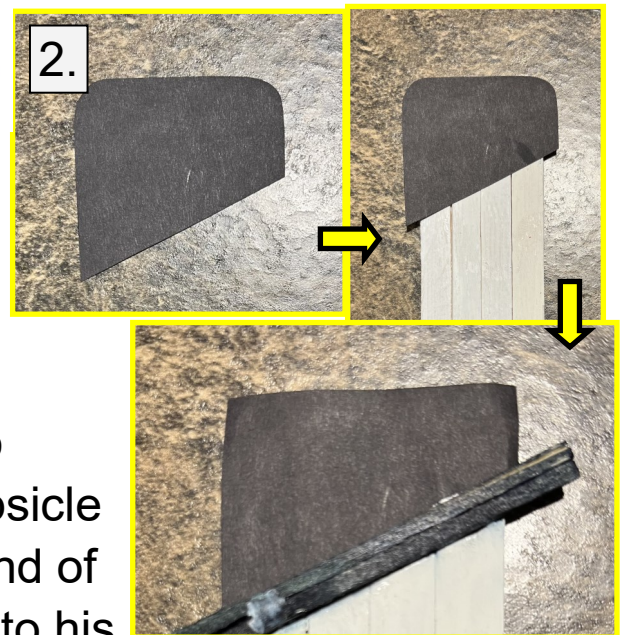
Materials: 4 popsicle sticks, 2 match sticks, construction paper, 2 pony beads, black marker, tacky glue, scissors

Directions:

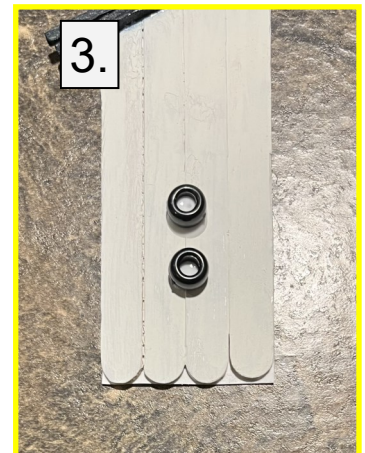
1. Start by gluing popsicle sticks to your white chunk of construction paper. Trim the edges. Make sure all parts with wood showing are facing the same direction.



2. Cut a slant in your square piece of paper for your snowman's hat. Color the two match sticks. Glue the black construction paper far enough down to cover up the wood showing on the popsicle sticks. Glue both match sticks at the end of the paper to give your snowman a rim to his hat.

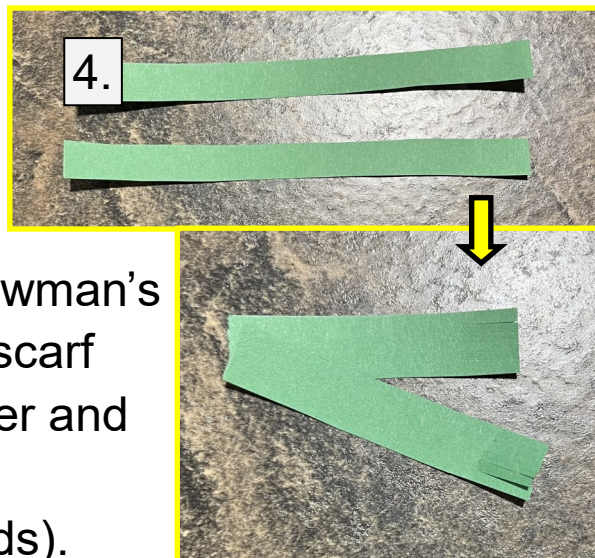


3. Glue both pony beads toward the bottom of the snowman's body to give them some buttons.

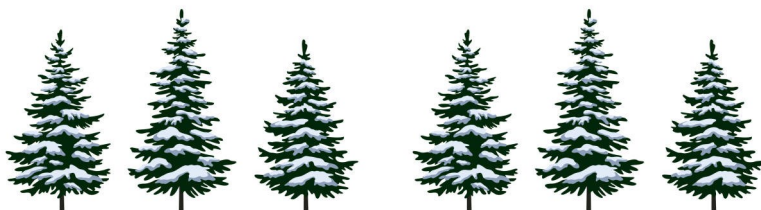

4. Once the hat and buttons are on your snowman's body, it's time for his scarf. Cut the colorful piece of construction paper into two equal strips. Cut them shorter to fit the snowman's body and trim the edges to give the scarf some texture. Glue one over the other and then glue the finished scarf onto the snowman (right above the pony beads).



5. Cut a carrot shape out of orange construction paper for the snowman's nose. Glue this above the scarf, making sure to leave room for your snowman's mouth. At this point, glue the paper snowflake onto the rim of the snowman's hat.



6. Draw eyes and a mouth onto your snowman with the black marker. We drew dots to make it look like coal!

You're all done! Enjoy your winter craft!
