



Make a Sloth Wall Hanging



Sloth Wall Hanging Directions

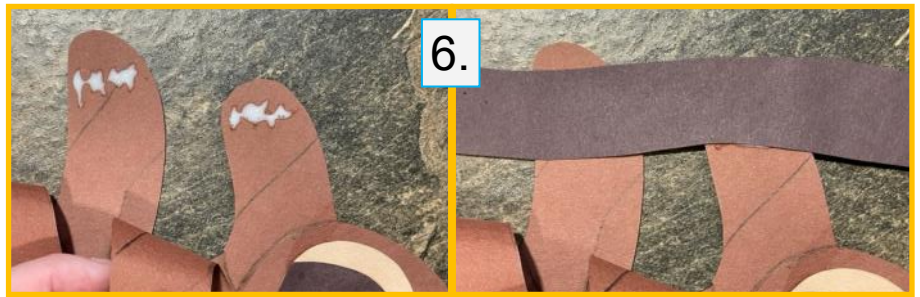
Materials: construction paper: medium brown, dark brown, black, cream, green; twine, glue sticks, tape, scissors, colored pencils

Directions:

1. Cut out the cream colored face and two small dark brown eye patches. Glue the eye patches onto the cream face. (Cut out the two cream claws and set aside for now.)
2. Using the black piece of paper, cut out a small nose and mouth. Glue those and the two pre-punched circles (eyes) onto the cream face. Set aside to dry.
3. Cut out the two pieces of body. Glue full body piece onto the partial body piece. Check out pictures for where to place glue (we used white glue for you to see location). **Do not** place glue on legs yet.
4. Glue the face onto the head of the body. Set aside to dry.
5. Cut out the long branch piece and leaves.



6. Lift top two legs up and place a little glue at tips of the legs underneath, then place branch on glue making sure to center the branch on sloth.



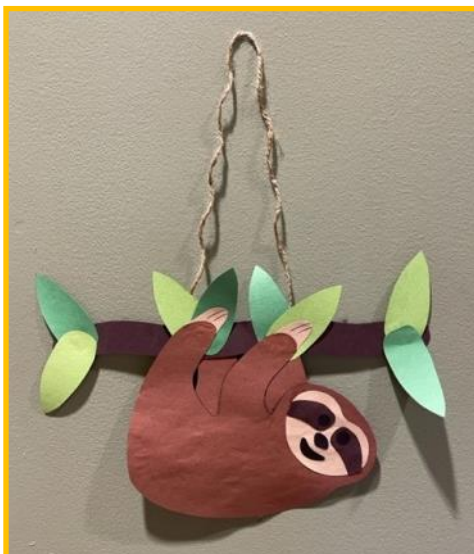
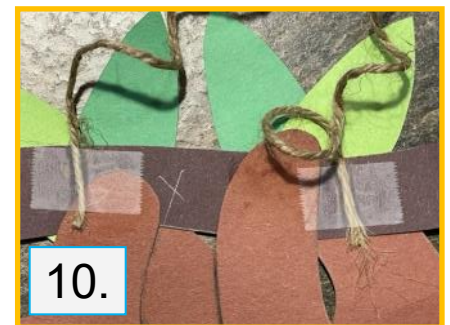
7. Glue down leaves onto the branch. We placed a couple under the ends of the legs. **Only** glue leaves to the branch.



8. Glue the cream claws onto the top two leg ends on the under side so that only half is sticking out. Glue the leg/claw to the leaves/branch underneath.



9. Use the dark colored pencil to give some depth to the body. We outlined some of the areas where the legs and head overlap the same colors. Add a couple lines to the claws to make separate-looking claws.



10. Flip over and tape twine onto the back of branch close to the legs.

11. Take your Sloth Wall Hanging home and hang it for everyone to see.
