

Make a Wood Cookie Owl




Wood Cookie Owl Directions


Materials: 1 wood cookie, 2 wiggle eyes, one piece of yellow or orange paper, 1 brown pipe cleaner, brown colored pencil, scissors, tacky glue

Directions:

1. Begin by drawing a triangle on your paper. Cut it out to create the beak.
2. Draw a wing shape on wood piece. You can lay out the eyes and beak if needed to make sure you like where your wings are placed.



3. Add whatever details your like to the wings.




4. Glue on the beak. Glue the eyes on the top corners of your beak.

5. Take your pipe cleaner and cut it in half.

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6. To create the feet, fold one half in a zig-zag shape. You need to fold it 5 times and end up with a longer tail at the end. You should have 3 points to make the toes of the feet.



7. Glue the long end to the back of your tree cookie/wood. You can glue the other end too if you'd like.

8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 with other half of the pipe cleaner.

9. Your owl is complete! Give it a fun name and fly around Woodhaven with it.



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
