

Make A Glass Beaded Suncatcher



Glass Bead Suncatcher Directions

Materials: Glass Beads, Wire, Waxed String - 60 inches and four 10 inches, Twine - 6 inches, Jar, Scissors, Glue

Directions:

1. Wrap your wire twice around the top of the jar loosely.

Twist the end of



the wire around itself to secure. (At the end you will tighten this.)

2. Feed the waxed string through the wire. Find the center so there is an even length on either side.



3. Add about 14 beads on one end of the string. Then, loop the loose end through the wire. Carefully pull the string to create a loop.



4. Repeat steps 2-3 until you've created 4 beaded loops. Tie each end of the string to the wire.



5. Cut the string into 4 even pieces. Tie the end of one piece to create a stopper, then add 12-14 beads.



6. Tie the string to the wire. Place between loops.



7. Repeat steps 5-6 for all short wire pieces. Tighten the wire.

8. Tie a piece of twine to either side of your jar to complete.



Glass Bead Suncatcher Directions

Materials: Glass Beads, Twine - 6 inches, Metal Jar Rim, Waxed String - five 16 inch pieces, Glue, Scissors

Directions:

1. Start by threading a single bead through fishing line three times. Tie a knot to secure the bead. This will be the bottom when hanging.



2. String a few beads onto the string. Make sure to thread the tail through these beads.

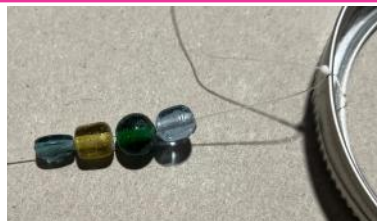


3. When you finish your first beaded section, tie a small knot. This will secure your section.



4. Repeat steps 1-3 to create another beaded section.

5. Attach your string to the jar rim by tying 2-3 knots. You can add a dab of glue to secure.



6. Repeat steps 1-5 for the other pieces of string.

7. Tie a piece of twine to either side of the rim. Trim extra tails of twine and string to complete your suncatcher.
