

Make A Painted Paver Owl



Painted Paver Owl Directions

Materials: crescent paver brick, paint (various colors, black & white), various paint brushes, black paint pen, pencil

Directions:

1. Paint the top and sides of the paver brick in your chosen base/body color. Let it dry. You may want multiple paint layers for better coverage or to touch up in rougher areas.



2. Draw the eyes, beak, and feathers.

Make sure the points of the brick are facing up.



3. Paint in the eyes. (We used yellow & black). You may need multiple layers of yellow.



4. Paint the beak orange. You may need multiple layers.



5. Add eye details. Use the paint pen or paint & a thin brush to outline.



6. Mix in a little black to the base or body owl color to make the lines for the feathers and wings.



6. Your paver owl is complete! If you place it outside, use a protective sealer so the paint stays bright.
