


Make A Rainforest Flower



Rainforest Flower Directions


Materials: 4-flower part templates in different colors of paper, green piece of paper (5.5"x4"), scissors, Elmer's glue

Directions:


1. Start by cutting out the 4 templates: 1 flower, 1 large circle, 1 medium circle, and 1 small circle. (Save the green square for later.)




2. Fold each of the 3 circles separately. Start with folding in half, then fold in half again.



3. Cut wedges into the **OPEN** end of the circle. Do not cut all the way through. This is to make the edges look frilly. Repeat on the other 2 circles.



4. Glue center of small circle onto medium circle. Glue that set to large circle. Glue set of 3 circles to the flower shape. Set aside.



6. Make a leaf out of green paper piece. Make large enough to see behind the flower. Glue to back of flower. Curl frilly edges up.



7. Your done! Take your rainforest flower home & hang it on the fridge!
