

# Make A Square Plastic Snowman



# Square Plastic Snowman

**Materials:** square plastic container (peanut/M&M), various ribbon (1/4"-1" width), 8oz paper snack cup, black (3mm)/orange (1mm) craft foam, black/white acrylic paint, white glitter, nose/hat template, paint brushes, pencil, hot glue & gun, glue (E6000); black gemstones: 2-20mm, 2-12mm, 3-8mm

## Directions:

1. Use black paint to cover the paper cup. Set aside to dry. (if you can find a black cup that's great!)



2. Place 2-tbsp white paint, 1-oz water, and a scoop of glitter (water was to loosen the white paint). Roll the plastic container to mix the paint, water, and glitter inside. Continue rolling to cover the entire container. (Use a paint brush if spots missed.)



3. Use the nose template to trace on the orange foam. Cut out.



4. Put lid on container. Lid is bottom of head (neck). Add eyes & mouth to flat side of container with E6000 glue. We used 20mm gemstones for eyes, and mixed 12mm & 8mm for the mouth.



5. Use a small dot of E6000 to attach nose to the snowman.



You may need to hold it down for a few seconds.

6. Using the 3mm black craft foam and template, cut out a 7-inch circle for the hat brim.



7. Put a small dot of E6000 on all four top corners of the container. Place black foam circle on the glue. You may need to hold it down for a few seconds. Glue the black snack cup on top to finish the hat. Using a thin ribbon, glue on a hat band.




8. Add the thicker ribbon to create a scarf around the 'neck' of the snowman.




8. Your done! Now you can decorate for winter or winter in July!
