

Make An Tissue Paper Butterfly Suncatcher



Tissue Paper Butterfly Suncatcher

Materials: 2 pieces contact paper, string, butterfly outline, butterfly shape, ~30 tissue paper pieces, colored pencils, scissors, hole punch

Directions:

1. Take one piece of contact paper and peel the sticky clear layer from the paper backing. Lay it on table sticky side up. (**adult help may be needed**)



2. Carefully stick butterfly **OUTLINE** to contact paper with the design side down. (At home find a picture online, print, & cut.)



3. Begin laying tissue paper to the sticky side of contact paper. **Be careful, once the paper is on, it cannot be removed.**



4. Continue adding tissue paper to the contact paper until your butterfly is full. You can cut the tissue paper smaller if you'd like.



5. Once your butterfly is filled in, carefully lay the second piece of contact paper on top.



6. Punch a hole in the top of your butterfly. Cut the string in half and thread it through the hole you made.



7. Color the full butterfly. Punch a hole in the top and string the other thread through the hole.
