

Make A TP Tube Parrot




TP Tube Parrot Directions


Materials: tp tube, colorful rectangle paper (~6"x4"), 3-style feather templates x2, yellow paper square, 5 feathers, 1 yellow pipe cleaner, 2-12mm wiggly eyes, scissors, Elmer's glue, glue stick, hole punch

Directions:


1. Start by gluing the large rectangle colored paper around the tp tube. We used the glue stick and a little Elmer's along the end edge. This is the body.




2. Cut out the 3-sets of feather pieces. Glue 3 different sized feathers on top of each other to create the wing.



3. Prepare legs. Hole punch 2 holes on bottom of the tube. Cut pipe cleaner in half. Attach pipe cleaner piece to each hole and twisty-tie. Leave hanging.



4. Using the yellow square, fold in half and cut out a beak. Glue the eyes and beak to the body.



5. Glue 2 smaller feathers inside tube above eyes.



6. Glue the rest of the feathers on the back side bottom for a tail. Let dry! (This may take a little more glue.)



7. Glue wings to either side.



8. Wrap your birds legs around your arm and fly home!
