

# Make a Clay Pot Scarecrow



# Clay Pot Scarecrow Directions

**Materials:** 2 clay pots, paint—orange, blue, tan, brown, & white, 4 candle cup beads, straw, 48 inches twine, burlap, tp tube, 4 pony beads, pencil, ruler, flower accessories, black paint pen, paint brushes, hot glue, E6000, tacky glue

## Directions:

(Pots: we used 3”t x 2.75”w on top. Candle cups used are 2.5”d x 2.25”h.)

1. On **pot 1**, draw details for its overalls, with an opening in front and on either side. Make sure the large opening is on bottom with the small drain hole



2. Paint orange in the areas you just created. You may need multiple layers of paint.



3. Paint **pot 2** tan, leaving rim unpainted. Paint the wood beads tan. This should take 1-2 coats.



4. On **pot 1**, paint the rest in blue. You may need multiple layers of paint.



5. Paint a dark brown rim on **pot 2**.



6. Use pencil to draw a face on **pot 2**. Make sure brown rim is facing up.



7. Paint the face. Use the black paint marker to finish details. Make sure the rest of the paint is dry before using the marker.



8. Cut twine ► 2- 6 inch, 2- 10 inch. The fifth piece will be used later for hat.

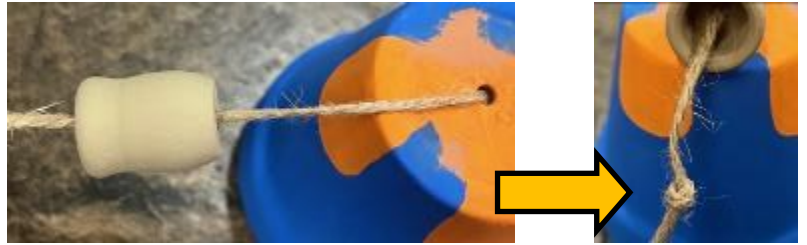
9. Tie a pony bead to the end of one of the 6 inch pieces.



10. Thread opposite end of twine through the hole in **pot 1**. You will thread through the inside with the twine coming through the outside.

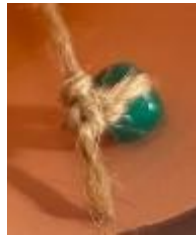


11. Thread tan bead on twine. It may help to twist the twine as you thread. Tie a knot at the end to have the bead (hand) sit where you'd like.



12. Repeat steps 9-11 with other 6 inch twine.

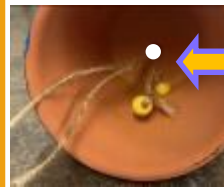
13. Tie a bead on end of both 10 inch pieces of twine.



14. Thread twine through open end of **pot 2** and down through **pot 1**. Ends should come out of open pot end.



15. Repeat step 11 for both pieces of twine making legs.



16. Paint details on the overalls.



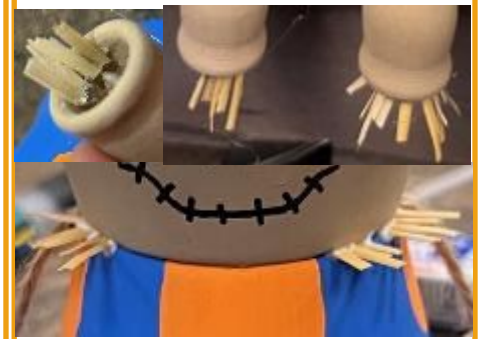
17. Go to glue station. Glue head & body together w/E6000 on bottom edge w/few hot glue dots for extra hold. Hot glue knotted areas in all spots.

18. Break up the straw and glue it on your scarecrow.



19. Use burlap and twine to create a hat for your scarecrow. Use a tp tube for base shape. Glue flower on and place hat on scarecrow.



20. Your scarecrow is complete!
